CONTRACTOR FAQs

What is the Onboarding Checklist?

The checklist is a helpful guide that outlines the employment forms that must be submitted and training elements that are required to work for the Brands.

What is the deadline to complete the Onboarding Process?

No later than October 6th or prior to your first scheduled event. Onboarding includes completing the Compliance video training and quizzes.

Do I need a valid background check each season?

Yes, it's important we have accurate information on file each season and a criminal background is required.

Who covers the cost of the Background Check?

All contractors are responsible for the cost. Valid reports may be used from other sources such a Government clearance report, another company, school background check or a report from a national background check service.

What is the rate of pay for services rendered?

Pay information will be provided via the event confirmation and outline different rates based the event position.

How soon will compensation be provided for services rendered?

All judges or core staff will receive pay via direct deposit which may take up to three days to process after the scheduled event. Event staff working as a group, EMT's, and/or Trainers will receive a check at the event.

What is the pay breakdown?

Total compensation is a flat rate and includes your base pay for working the event and an additional stipend included in the payment for meals not covered onsite, travel incidentals such luggage and/or parking fees, UBER or LYFT fees to/from the airport for those flying to the event (unless notified differently); mileage for those driving to/ from the event. **Note:** As a contractor, it's your prerogative to use the proceeds as you see fit and your payment should not be viewed as "total" base pay. Our compensation rates are highly competitive.

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When will communication be available for assigned events?

Communication will be available 7-10 days prior to each event. Email alerts will be sent to prompt contractors to view important information.

What the baseline score to be cleared for training compliance?

The baseline line score is 80% for both quizzes; one attempt is granted for each quiz and time allotment is one hour and 30 minutes.

When will quiz retakes be available for scores less than 80%?

Participants will have multiple to attempts to achieve the baseline score.

What are the access codes for compliance, training and scheduled events?
